


EXAMPLE OF LOT TYPES





DEFINITIONS

is a lot abutting on two streets at their intersection, where the angle of intersection is not more than 135 degrees. CORNER LOT

REVERSED CORNER LOT

is a corner lot the street side lot line of which is substantially a continuation of the front lot line of the first lot to its rear.

INTERIOR LOT is a lot other than a corner or reversed corner lot.

THROUGH LOT

is a lot having a pair of opposite lot lines along two more or less parallel public streets. On a through lot both street lines shall be

deemed front lot lines.
